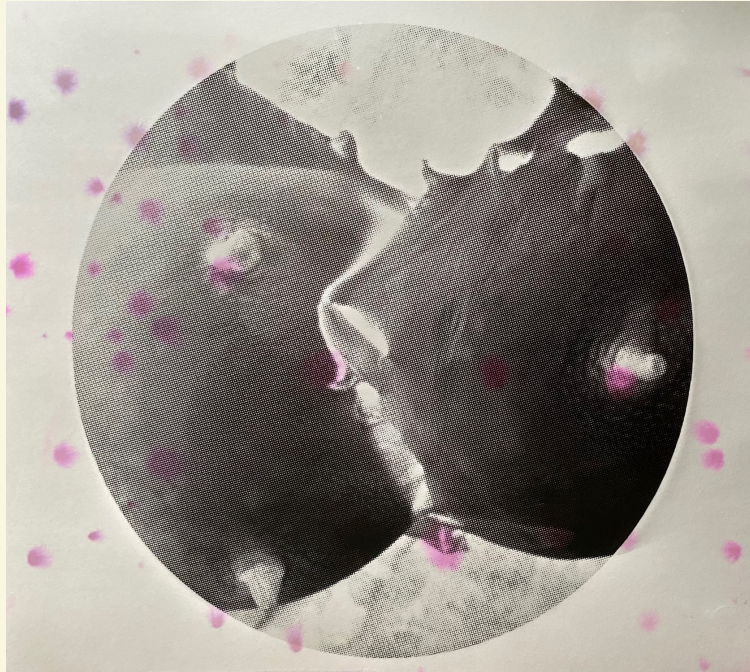

# **Dark Brew – The Alchemist**

***Dark Brew: The Alchemist*** combines alternative photography processes that include chemigrams, contact prints, photograms and chemical painting made with fibre-based photographic paper.

During this exhibition Simone has created a working darkroom in the gallery, collaborating with visitors to create unique artworks that respond to the theme of Simone’s exhibition *Dark Brew: The Alchemist*

**‘This installation draws on stories of women from the past and present as healers, mothers, and alchemists. Highlighting connections to the earth and the passage of time’**

Simone's practice involves using experimental photographic processes to create works that directly respond to the physical and psychological body, with a focus on producing spontaneous emissions of the self. The final works are often formed somewhere between direct representation and abstraction. This is often created in collaboration with nature, in the field and within the darkroom often engaging with experimentation in the use of photographic chemicals painted directly onto the paper, prints often left unfixed. Through this process, Simone continues to engage with recurring themes of impermanence and the body in her work.

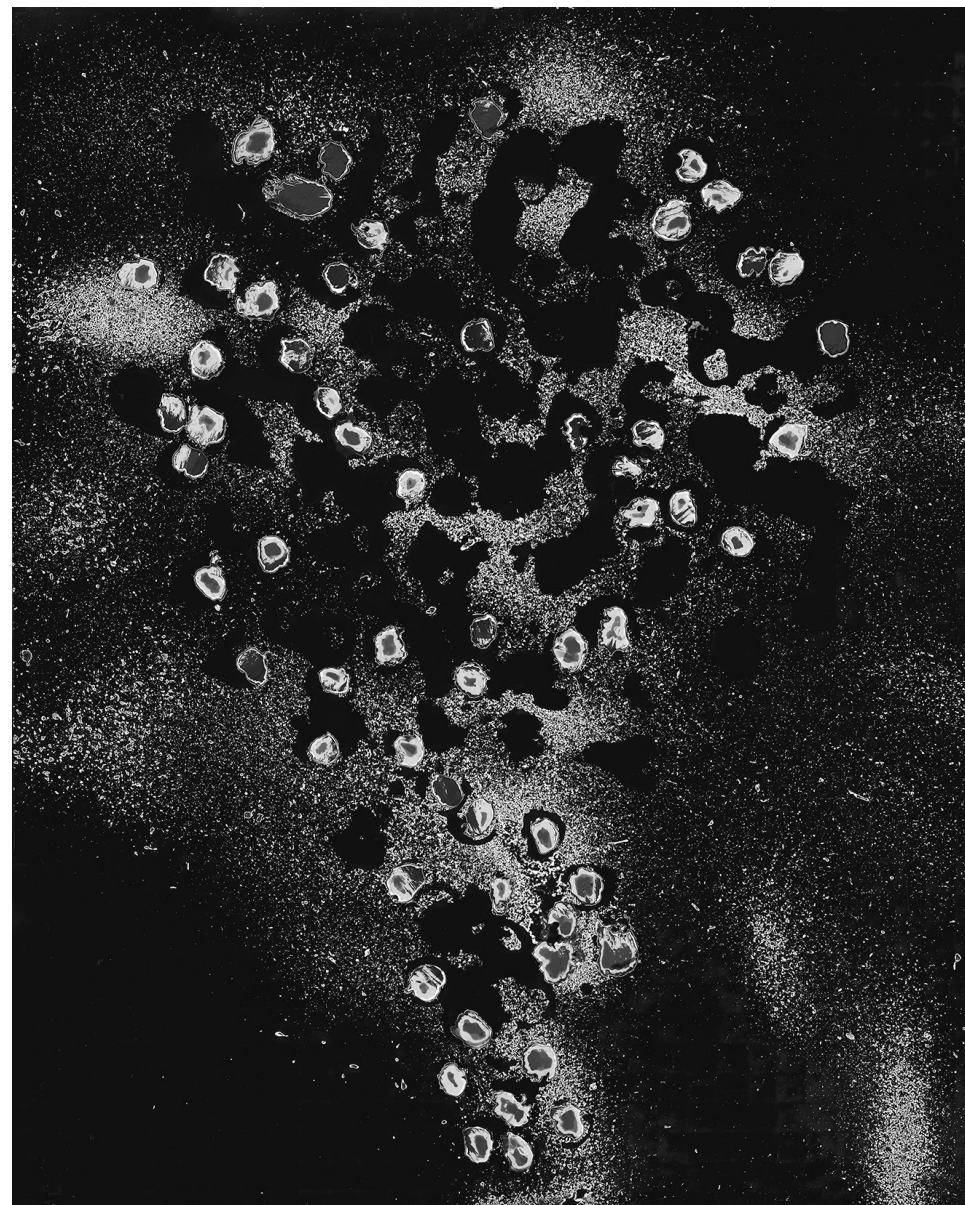

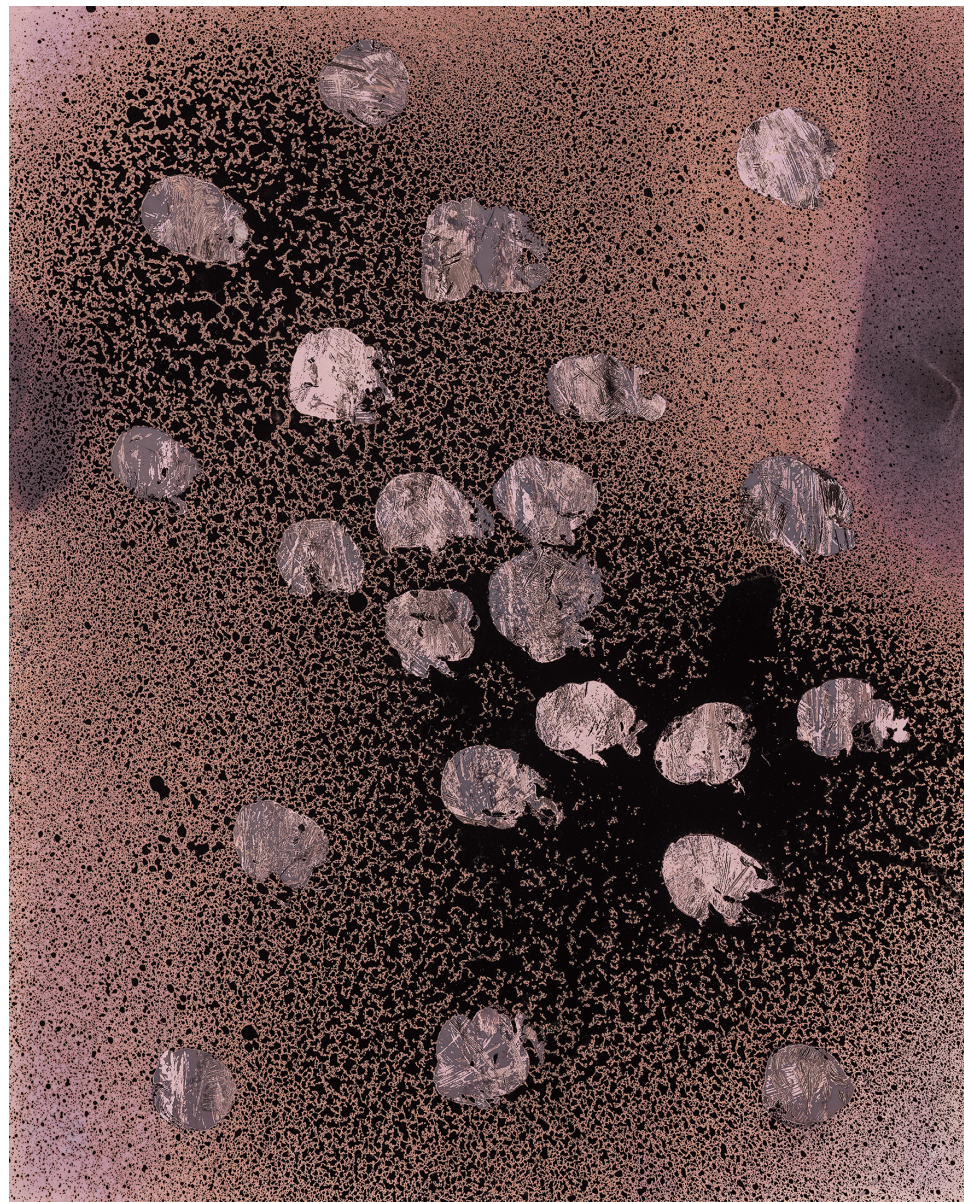

## *Biography*

Simone Darcy (Born in Bedgerabong, Central West NSW) is an artist currently based in Southern Tasmania.

From a darkroom practice Simone Darcy uses performance strategies within the still image, constructing ideas of abstraction, embodiment and self; along with experimental photographic processes often in collaboration with nature to give visual form to the intangible and the ephemeral

Simone has shown her work in Australia and Internationally, this has included Point North at the Reykjavik Museum of Photography in Iceland; Verge Gallery Sydney; Arts System Wickham and selected as part of the Gaffa Experimental Photo Festival Award Sydney; Other notable exhibitions include Embody at Cement Fondu Sydney; Light Objects – Photography in the Expanded Field at Perth Centre of Photography; The Bus Stop Project at Maitland Regional Art Gallery and Absence at Span 1,2 & 3 Melbourne

Simone has been a shortlisted artist in the Gosford Art Prize; Mullins Conceptual Photo Prize, Muswellbrook Regional Arts Centre; The National Photographic Portrait Prize, The Portrait Gallery Canberra; Head On Portrait Prize, Australian Centre of Photography; The Portrait Prize, Queensland Centre of Photography; The New York Photo Prize; The Josephine Ulrick & Win Schubert Photographic Prize; MAMA National Photography Prize; Melbourne Photobook Image Award and was the recipient of the Ilford Salon Portrait Award at the Centre for Contemporary Photography, Melbourne. Simone has undertaken residencies at All That We Are and AIRspace Oatlands (Tasmania), Studio Kura (Japan), NES Artists (Iceland). With upcoming residencies at Rosny Farm Arts Centre, Hobart and QBank Gallery, Queenstown in 2024
